WATERMAIN PROJECT**

This construction notice contains construction details for the section of the watermain that will be constructed along Kennedy Road from Steeles Avenue to the Milliken Reservoir.

Construction Start Date: January, 2010*
End Date: January, 2011*

Project Overview:
A 1500mm diameter watermain has been proposed by Toronto along Kennedy Road from Steeles Avenue to the Milliken Pumping Station and Reservoir located south of 14th Avenue.

Construction Details:

Watermain construction work taking place within Markham will involve tunnelling underground along Kennedy Road from the Toronto boundary to about 250m north of Steeles Avenue. The excavation work will continue to the south side of Milliken Mills Community Centre and into the Milliken Pumping Station.
