Being a by-law to delegate authority to execute
conditional permit agreements to Town staff

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM HEREBY
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT authority to execute conditional permit agreements on behalf of the Town be delegated to:

- (a) The Chief Administrative Officer where site plan approval is required and site plan endorsement has not yet been obtained; or,

- (b) The Chief Building Official where

- site plan approval is not required; or
- site plan approval is required and site plan endorsement has been obtained;
or
- site plan approval has been obtained.
