## NOTICE Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

Williams House 10760 Victoria Square Blvd Markham, ON

The Williams House has design value and physical value as a representative example of a vernacular village dwelling of frame construction dating from the late nineteenth century. The Williams House has historical value for its association with the theme of urban development, specifically the late nineteenth century period of development of the historic crossroads hamlet of Victoria Square. Further, the property has contextual value as one of a grouping of nineteenth and early twentieth century buildings that are important in defining, maintaining and supporting the character and extent of the historic crossroads hamlet of Victoria Square.
