



Environment - Summary of Public Comments and Concerns

- Preserve valuable green space and ensure that it is publicly accessible
- The pedestrian pathways should connect to other communities through the green spaces
- Convert Street E (road connection to Angus Glen Blvd.) into a pedestrian pathway
- Tree preservation and compensation for loss of trees is very important
- Assess impacts on wildlife habitat and possible endangered species
- All levels of government should work together to preserve the property and create a legacy for Unionville
- Stormwater management, high water table, wetlands and potential flooding need to be carefully considered
- · Potential impacts on existing water wells need to be assessed
- Reduction of the number of stormwater management ponds should be considered
- Environmental impacts of possible road connection to Warden Avenue need to be considered
