2. UPDATE ON YORK UNIVERSITY CORPORATION

Bud Purves, York University Development Corporation addressed the Committee and provided a verbal update. He advised that the University and the Province are working on the funding documents. He also advised that they are currently working on a presentation to provide an update at the next meeting (March 20, 2017) relative to the Innovation Hub that should be ready to open in June of 2017. Mr. Purves indicated that the planning process is proceeding very well and that they

anticipate submitting their site plan application in the Fall 2017. It was noted that there will be a future session with Markham Centre landowners to discuss what Markham will look like in 2024 and ensure that there is a common vision between York University, City of Markham and Markham landowners.

The Committee thanked Mr. Purves for his update and suggested that their presentation on the Innovation Hub include what it is intended for and space allocation. It was also suggested that at the next meeting an update regarding the programming status be included.
