**NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION
 SCHEDULE C, MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY
 FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO VICTORIA SQUARE BOULEVARD
 (FROM WOODBINE AVENUE TO WOODBINE AVENUE)**

The City of Markham has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study for transportation improvements to Victoria Square Boulevard (VSB). The planned improvements will benefit all transportation modes including cyclists, pedestrians, transit users and motorists.

The EA study identified the following recommendations for VSB:

- Continuous urban cross-section with one lane of traffic in each direction.
- Continuous two-way centre left-turn lane.
- Continuous multi-use paths on both sides to accommodate pedestrians and cyclists.
- On-street parking on one side of the street for portions of the corridor.

The City of Markham will proceed with design of the project following completion of the Class EA. An Environmental Study Report (ESR) documenting the study process and the recommended plan has been prepared. This Notice of Completion places the ESR on public record for a 30-calendar day review period ending on July 13, 2018.
