Odour Assessment

- Acceptable Ontario Standard: 1 OU/m³ (odour unit / m³)
- Sept 2013 Assessment
 - 1 OU/m³ exceeded 34 hrs / yr (0.4% of the time)
 - 99.5% of time odour levels less than 0.82 OU/m³
 - This meets MOE Standards (Ontario Regulation 419/05)
- Treat odour as a nuisance
- Odour caused by low concentrations of various volatile organic compounds (VOC's)
- No detectable concentrations of hydrogen sulphide (H₂S)



Fence Repairs

 Fence upgrade included in Operations 2014 Capital Budget

Noise Attenuation

- City By-Law Dept. conducted noise study from resident upstairs window on Aug 20, 2013
- Allowable Noise Level: 45 dB
- Ambient Noise Level: 49.9 dB
- Noise Level with Motor On: 51.3 dB
- Motor Noise Level is not significant
- City will be installing a noise deflector in October 2013




Blower House Drainage

- Two driveway culverts have been replaced
- Underground pipe repair to reduce moisture entering the suction blower and exhaust will be carried out in Oct/ Nov 2013

Additional Groundwater Wells (Cont'd)

Rationale

- Better define geology and groundwater quality
- Evaluate extent of leachate-impacted groundwater and possibility of impacting sensitive receptors such as German Mills Creek)
- Determine if additional measures for mitigation will be required

Work Description

- Two to three week duration
- No trees or bushes will be disturbed
- Disturbed areas will be restored
- TRCA has issued permit
- MNR has issued letter of advice
- Construction equipment: drilling rig, dump truck

Settlement Analysis

September 2013 Report

- Ground elevations during the March 2013 and July 2013 surveys were the same
- Another survey was completed in September and results will be forth coming



Work Plan for balance of 2013/2014

- Underground pipe rehabilitation at Blower House
- Installation of Noise Control Deflector
- Back up diesel generator
- Drilling of additional groundwater wells
- Complete indoor monitoring program
- Install signage
- Repairs to Gas Collection System
- Fence Repairs at the Entrance
