

Wallace Joyce Scholarship

The Award:

Mr. Wallace Joyce touched the lives of countless people in Markham. He was a champion of the arts and supported many organizations throughout his life. The Varley-McKay Art Foundation of Markham celebrates Mr. Joyce's contributions through an award offered in his name.

The Wallace Joyce Scholarship is a \$1000 bursary that supports students from York Region pursuing their studies in an art-related field at a post-secondary level. There is one recipient per year.

Eligibility:

- Graduating York Region high school student
- Pursuing visual arts, design or a related field of study at a post-secondary level

Selection Process:

Students will submit their application package for the Wallace Joyce Scholarship Award. The Varley Art Gallery of Markham's Manager will lead the selection process and sit on the selection jury. The successful applicant will be contacted within a month of the application deadline.

Application Requirements:

The award candidate shall submit the following to the Varley-McKay Art Foundation of Markham's Development Officer at fdauphinais@markham.ca

- A completed application form
- A curriculum vitae
- A selection of the student's works
- A letter of documenting the enrolment of the student in an art college or university
- A statement written by the student explaining their art practice
- A reference letter from their teacher
